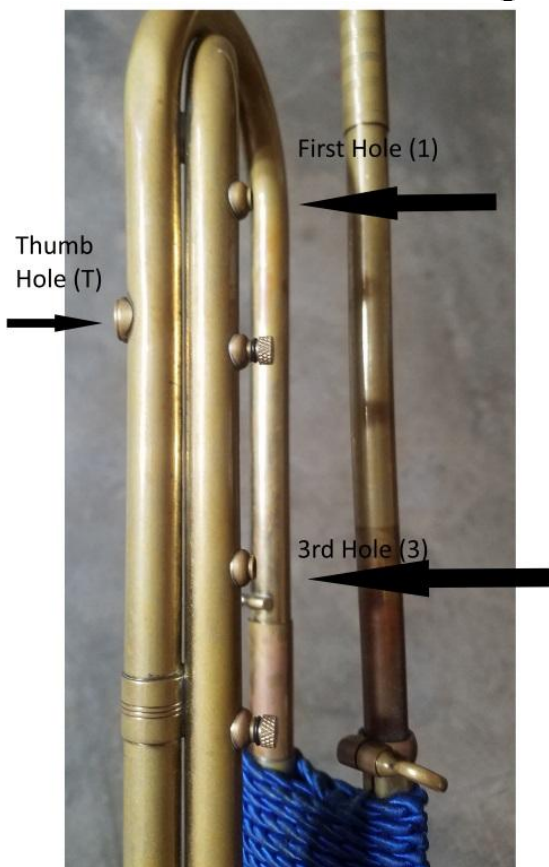


# Baroque Trumpet Fingering Chart

(3-hole system)

Fingerings below indicate which fingerhole to vent (open).  
Fingers not indicated should be closed.  
Notes with no indication should be played with all holes closed.

Fingerings in ( ) parentheses indicate possible alternate fingerings  
Fingerings in [ ] brackets are possible ways to play certain problematic, uncommon notes.

1 = First Hole (index finger)  
3 = Third Hole (ring or pinky finger)  
T = Thumb Hole

Many 3-hole instruments have adjustable screw placements. I commonly place my screws on the 2nd and 4th holes, as seen pictured. This may vary due to instrument, player, tuning, and temperament.

Players should also practice playing all of these notes with all holes closed.
